

Nursery Fees

Please could we remind all Parents/Carers that nursery fees have to be paid by the 1st of the month, otherwise they will incur late payment fees of £5 per day. This also means that vouchers need to be cleared before the 1st for that month otherwise they will be counted towards the following month's payment.

Famly Nursery App

Hopefully, all Parents/Carers have now managed to have a look at the Famly app, and are finding it useful.

We are going to be using this app instead of having the folders with the children's observations in, so these will be sent home shortly.

If any Parents/Carers are having any problems with Famly, then please speak to a member of staff in your child`s room or Katie in the office.

<u>Weather</u>

As we will be going into the cooler weather can Parents/Carers please ensure that children have coats and wellington boots in nursery, to prevent them from not being able to join their friends outdoors.

Spare Clothes

Can we please remind Parents/Carers to send in a spare set of clothes for all children as sometimes during play they do get messy and need changing. We do have a small supply of spare clothes but not always in the correct sizes for the children that require them. If your child does come home from nursery in spare clothes please can we ask that they are returned to nursery for use when other children need them.



During this term we are going to be exploring the world around us by going out on more trips to the park and library.

We will also be outside exploring the garden lots, so please don`t forget coats and shoes for your child/ren.

Could we please have a family photo of each child to go on our family photo board, this encourages the children to recognise people who are special to them.

If your child acheives something at home they have not done before like standing up or walking for the first time, please do let a member of staff know so we can put this in their Learning Journey.



During this term we are going to be doing lots of creative activities, including painting, sticking, sponge painting and mark making using a variety of resources.

We are going to be going out into the community more and talking to the children about the world around them.

We are going to be out in the garden looking for bugs and also looking for signs of Autumn. Please remember to send coats and wellies in.

We are also going to be exploring messy play to encourage the children to use their senses and use describing worlds to tell us how it feels, smells and looks.

We would like to welcome all the new children who have joined the room and wish Happy Birthday to all of our children who turned 3 during the Summer Holiday and are going to be part of the Caterpillar Room.



We would like to welcome all of the children who are starting the school term with us and who are returning from the Summer Holidays. This term we will be focusing on our confidence and making new friends. We will start the term off by doing lots of small group activities and then moving on to doing large group activities as the children`s confidence grows.

We are going to be taking the children to the library once a month, to choose books that they would like to bring back to nursery to share with their peers.

Please can we remind Parents/Carers to send in wellies and waterproof coats so that children can still enjoy the outdoors when it is wet.

We will be continuing with sports sessions so please can children have a PE kit left on their peg so they can get changed and start learning how to dress and undress themselves in preparation for school.
